








## Directions for Making an Experience Book

WHAT YOU NEED:	LOOKS LIKE THIS:
<p>Two covers (made of cardboard, poster board, or manila file folders) about 6" x 7" with two or three holes punched on the left side.</p>	
<p>About 5 pages of heavy weight paper (same size or slightly smaller than the covers). Old manila file folders work well.</p>	
<p>Two or three simple rings to hold books together.</p>	
<p>Objects, partial objects, pictures, or photos to go on each page.</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  <p>flower</p> </div>	<div style="display: flex; justify-content: space-around;"> <div style="text-align: center;">  <p>rock</p> </div> <div style="text-align: center;">  <p>twig</p> </div> </div>
<p>Write and/or use Braille labeler on each page. Written sentence should be on the cover and each page even if Braille is used.</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  </div>
