### **Monday, March 30**

Self-Awareness Success (Part 1) with Robbin Keating-Clark, Utah Schools for the Deaf and Blind

- Goal: Students will define self-awareness. Students can analyze their thoughts & feelings.
- For upper elementary, middle & high school; moderate & typically developing student ability level
- Materials needed: Students will need a device for journaling.

### **Tuesday, March 31**

Marvin's Market Adventure and Grandma's Special Birthday Picnic with Gwyn McCormack, Positive Eye

- Goal: To participate in a fun meaningful literacy experience and enjoy creating some of the story items following the session
- Pre-school - 2nd grade or students with moderate additional disabilities
- Materials Needed: A purse, a shopping bag, some coins, a boy doll for Marvin (if possible but not essential); a carrot, a potato, and a flower (not essential, but great if available)

### **Wednesday, April 1**

### **Thursday, April 2**

Fun with Braille with Tammy Reisman, UMass Boston & Newton Public Schools

- Goal: To reinforce and practice beginning braille reading and writing skills
- For beginning braille readers/learners (or anyone that wants some fun braille enrichment activities)
- Pre-requisite Knowledge: use of braille writer, beginning reading skills
- Materials Needed: play dough or clay, braille writer, braille paper, favorite braille book

### **Friday, April 3**

Time for Tots with Renee Ellis, Texas School for the Blind and Visually Impaired, Outreach

- Goal: Using songs, music, and movement to support literacy, motor and cognitive development. Note that this session will be a bit different from others, in that we will do activities for the children for the first 30 minutes (approximately), followed by discussion with the parents and caregivers.
- For children 0-5 years old, with their parent or caregiver
