Special Symbols

⠠⠠⠠	Dot locator for "mention" (dots 4-6, dots 1-2-3-4-5-6) - In Unified English Braille (UEB), this symbol is used to set a braille symbol apart so that it can be defined, described, or discussed.
⠠⠠⠠ ⠠⠠⠠	Opening Nemeth Code indicator (dots 4-5-6, dots 1-4-6)
⠠⠠⠠ ⠠⠠⠠	Nemeth Code terminator (dots 4-5-6, dots 1-5-6)
⠠⠠⠠ ⠠	Opening simple fraction indicator (dots 1-4-5-6)
⠠⠠⠠ ⠠	Horizontal fraction line (dots 3-4)
⠠⠠⠠ ⠠	Closing simple fraction indicator (dots 3-4-5-6)
⠠⠠⠠ ⠠	Plus sign (dots 3-4-6)
⠠⠠⠠ ⠠	Minus sign (dots 3-6)
⠠⠠⠠ ⠠⠠⠠	Multiplication cross (dot 4, dots 1-6)
⠠⠠⠠ ⠠	Multiplication dot (dots 1-6)
⠠⠠⠠ ⠠⠠⠠	Division (divided by) sign (dots 4-6, dots 3-4)
⠠⠠⠠ ⠠⠠⠠	Equals sign (dots 4-6, dots 1-3)
⠠⠠⠠ ⠠⠠⠠	Less than sign (dot 5, dots 1-3)
⠠⠠⠠ ⠠⠠⠠	Greater than sign (dots 4-6, dot 2)

Additional symbols (only in version with variables)

⠠⠠⠠⠠⠠ Superscript indicator (dots 4-5)

⠠⠠⠠⠠⠠ Baseline indicator (dot 5)
