| ⠠⠠⠠ | Dot locator for "mention" (dots 4-6, dots 1-2-3-4-5-6) - In Unified English Braille (UEB), this symbol is used to set a braille symbol apart so that it can be defined, described, or discussed. |
| ⠠⠠⠠ ⠠⠠⠠ | Opening Nemeth Code indicator (dots 4-5-6, dots 1-4-6) |
| ⠠⠠⠠ ⠠⠠⠠ | Nemeth Code terminator (dots 4-5-6, dots 1-5-6) |
| ⠠⠠⠠ ⠠ | Left-pointing arrowhead (dots 2-4-6) |
| ⠠⠠⠠ ⠠⠠ | Line (axis line) (dots 2-5) |
| ⠠⠠⠠ ⠠⠠⠠ | Coordinate scale mark (dots 1-2-3-5) |
| ⠠⠠⠠ ⠠⠠⠠ | Right-pointing arrowhead (dots 1-3-5) |
